

Weiti Boating Club Policy 03/10/11

Hardstand Sanding Activities:

During any activity in the yard or shed no residue, dust, paint-flakes or shavings shall be left on the yard surface or be allowed to cross any Weiti Boating Club boundary. These outcomes shall be achieved by way of:

- 1) a total ban on wet sanding or wet abrading, exempted only by individuals submitting a written Run-Off Management Plan for approval by the committee prior to commencing wet sanding or wet abrading.
- 2) mandatory use of vacuum extracted machines when dry sanding or dry abrading with any machine
- 3) drop cloths and shrouds to encase the work area to prevent dust or residue migration when dry hand sanding, dry machine sanding or dry cutting
- 4) diligent, comprehensive and detailed hardstand clean-up as required to stop residue, dust, paint flakes or shavings being blown or washed away from the immediate area under the boat. Clean up to be carried out at least once per day or more frequently as required to remain compliant with this policy.

Weiti Boating Club Incorporated Policy:

- It is Weiti Boating Club's policy that all personnel undertaking boat maintenance and repairs must comply with the provisions of the Resource Management Act and Auckland Council's Draft Boat Maintenance Policy published by the ARC, 1995.
