

# Plan to leave nothing behind

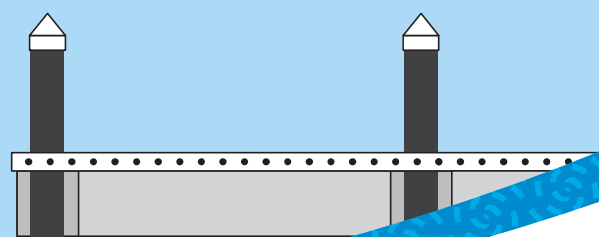
If you're planning to visit Aotea / Great Barrier Island this summer, choose reusable containers, bring minimal packaging and take your waste away with you.

## If you need to dispose of waste while visiting:

- A user-pays land-based drop-off service will be open at Port Fitzroy wharf from 10am to 3pm Tuesday to Saturday from 21 December 2019 to 1 February 2020. Closed Christmas Day & New Year's Day. EFTPOS only.
- Use the roadside rubbish and recycling collection service for council rubbish bags, wheelie bins and recycling crates – place out before 8am on your collection day (Monday).
- Buy council 60-litre rubbish bags for \$3.90 each from the service centre – Monday to Friday, 8:30am – 5pm.
- Council rubbish bags may also be available for purchase from your local store.
- Drop off your waste to Aotea Community Recycling Centre / Claris Landfill. Extended hours between 23 December 2019 and 2 February 2020 are 9am to 4pm Monday to Friday and 10am to 3pm every Saturday. Closed Sundays and public holidays. Gate fees may apply. Clean and sorted recycling will be accepted free of charge. Council rubbish bags will also be accepted for free.
- All public bins including the waste stations at Port Fitzroy, Whangaparapara, Tryphena / Shoal Bay and outside the Claris Landfill, have closed.
