

## Weiti Boating Club - COVID-19 Level 2

Under level 2 all club facilities will open again and we ask the following:

- 1) Please adhere to the social distancing rules, 2 metres with people you don't know and 1 metre with people you do know.
- 2) If you are unwell please stay away from the club, if you are worried about your boat call the office on 09 424 5905 and we can check on it for you.
- 3) If you come down to the club for any reason we need to know for contact tracing. You can leave your details on the form in the clubhouse or leave a message on the office phone 09 424 5905 with the day, time, email, best contact number, your name and the people with you.
- 4) Please use the disinfectant on the dinghy locker locks and the hand sanitiser in the clubhouse.

### Notice to Competitors and Race Management Volunteers

All competitors and Race Management volunteers must make themselves aware of COVID-19 and the risks involved. Information is available on the COVID website <https://www.health.govt.nz/>

As a prerequisite to entering, sailing or Race Management volunteering in a Weiti Boating Club race, you agree your personal information may be shared with the local Public Health Authorities to enable rapid contact tracing if a participant or volunteer at the event becomes ill with COVID-19 or has been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

The following **mandatory precautions** must be taken to be able to race / Race Management volunteer in all Weiti Boating Club races.

- Mandatory Contact tracing of all crew - **This is the responsibility of the skipper. Also Refer NOR/SI's Safety Regulations.** Contact details of all race crew must also be provided to the Weiti Boating Club – email [info@weiti.co.nz](mailto:info@weiti.co.nz)
- You should not let any person onto your boat who display flu-like or COVID-19 symptoms. Ask people who display flu-like symptoms to self-isolate.
- Gatherings and people on board must be restricted to a maximum of 10 people.
- Skippers are responsible for disinfecting surfaces on board their boats before and after use, with regular cleaning of high use items or handhelds like VHF, winches, winch handles and door handles.
- Wash sailing gloves and shared equipment like life jackets after every use.
- Skippers are encouraged to advise crew to provide their own food and drink with no sharing to avoid cross contamination, maintain good hygiene like regular washing and drying of hands or using hand sanitiser, and encourage good cough/sneeze etiquette and avoiding touching your face.
- There will be no prize giving at the Weiti Boating club after racing until further notice. Prizes can be collected from the club office during normal office hours.

Maintain physical distancing of 2 metres wherever possible, especially from people you do not know. It is recognised that contact during physical activity will occur, but this should be minimised as much as possible.
